- 5 = excellent (Official is capable of working the next level)
- 4 = needs only minor improvement (Official may be capable of working the next level)
- 3 = average (Official is working at the correct level)
- 2 = sub-par, needs improvement (Official is not performing well)
- 1 = unsatisfactory, barely acceptable
